**SUMMARY OF MEETING:**

**WARNINGS/LABELS:** The task group chair, Rachael Shaggot, began with a recap of IDI's related to deaths on changing tables to determine whether they should be addressed by the warning labels task group or the newly formed entrapment task group. The group agreed the deaths are all related to unsafe sleep on changing products and should be addressed via warning labels that warn caregivers that changing surfaces are not meant for sleeping. The discussion then turned to proposed warning label content and how to ensure each type of changing product had label content that adequately addresses those types of unsafe sleeping incidents.

**The group reviewed the format label contents should follow: state the hazard, (specifically what happens to kids), then state what action the caregiver should follow to avoid the hazard. Each hazard needs it's own section/paragraph. It was noted that the statement "always secure to support" statement for changing table accessories for play yards needs to be re-looked at since that statement is already required by the play yard standard (but it's under the suffocation hazard). Team will think about whether it's worth restating it under the fall hazard in changing table warning requirements, or if the play yard standard already has it sufficiently covered. Possible options will be reviewed off line by the team.**

**Rachael will send the group's final versions out for review one more time by the group to prepare to ballot.**
