## **SUMMARY OF MEETING:**

The ASTM task group on changing table warnings discussed proposed revisions to the warning section of the voluntary standard, including the following topics:

- **Introduction: Discussed adding “suffocation” to introduction to address new warning for suffocation hazards.**
- **Terminology: Discussed proposed definitions for changing table accessory, changing product, and other changing products. The group discussed if the suggested change to “changing table accessory” would preclude changing table accessories attached to bassinets. The issue was tabled for later discussion.**
- **Warnings, including ad hoc formatting language: The task group discussed if the wording was intended to be “addressed,” if all (vs. only one or two) example warnings labels should be shown, and reviewed the entire proposed ballot.**
- **Instructions: New section for task group work. CPSC staff raised the modification included in the staff briefing package in section 10.1.1. In addition, a number of other modifications were discussed to address the use of “changing products.”**
