**Summary:**

The UL 8400 STP is developing a proposed draft standard for virtual reality equipment. This was a working meeting of task group 7, which is working on requirements for the section entitled Allergic Contact Dermatitis. The UL 8400 task group 7 discussed the development of section 7 of the proposed draft UL 8400 standard. The title of section 7 is Allergic contact dermatitis (ACD) and it addresses the potential effects of materials used in VR headsets. Staff participated in discussion about changing the title of the section to “skin compatibility”. Staff also participated in discussions on the scope of the testing and the inclusion of release of chemicals from VR components and subsequent exposure to users. UL 8400 task group 7 will next meet via teleconference on October 27.
